

Guidelines for Papers for NAGC R&E 2021 Dissertation Award

Format

- Double spaced
- 1 inch margins
- 12-point font (Times New Roman)
- APA formatting (Use the most current edition of the Publication Manual)

Components

1. Title Page
 1. Contact information for author
 2. University affiliation where the research was conducted
 3. 3-5 keywords
2. Abstract
 - a. 100-150 words
 - b. Blinded for review
3. Main Text
 - a. Maximum of 25 pages (exclusive of references, tables, and figures)
 - b. Blinded for review
4. Reference List
5. Tables and Figures
 - a. Each table/figure on a separate page

Eligibility

All participants must be members of NAGC. After submission of paper, any participant who is not a member will be asked to join.

Dissertation Research studies must have been completed within the last two years (January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020). The research must have been conducted while the graduate student was a doctoral candidate and must be the original work of the recent graduate.

Content

All research papers should consider a topic regarding the field of gifted education. Qualitative, Quantitative, Mixed-Methods, and Meta-analysis research studies are most appropriate.
