Register via mail or fax by October 26, 2009. After that date, you may register onsite. Payment in full is expected at time of registration.

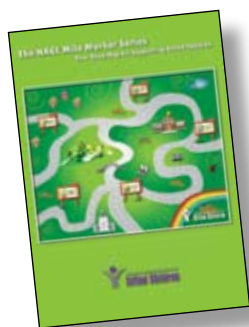
